<p>Success Stories</p>	<p>The below information is about a domestic worker from Sierra Leone. She is 33 years old. She came to Lebanon for the sake of the domestic work. In her country of origin, she was told she was coming to work as a nanny with the 3 employer’s kids. She received only 2 salaries out of 7 where she started being abused.</p> <p>The employer has made cuts all over her body, whipped her, burned her with an iron, hit her in both her eyes, where she cannot see any more in her left eye, the abuse’s marks are all over her body, with sores and cuts all over. She has a cracked tooth, and her hair was cut.</p> <p>She was deprived from food, there for she is very skinny. She was referred to Caritas Lebanon safe shelter for protection and medical aid since she was bleeding from her wounds. At the safe shelter she was granted with a Warm Embrace and Active Listening Basic Assistance: food, material needs,</p>

Psychosocial: Psychological (Group & individual sessions) Case Management Medical: preventive & curative services Legal: legal representation and

counseling Activities: life skills sessions, livelihood sessions, recreational “You’re not a victim for sharing your story, you are a survivor setting the world on fire with your truth. And you never know who needs your light, your warmth and courage”.
